



PHYSICAL EXAMINATION, IMMUNIZATION, DENTAL AND VISION REQUIREMENTS 2017-18

All students must be compliant with the State of Illinois **Physical Examination and Immunization requirements prior to August 1st, 2017**. Student's that do not meet these requirements **will not be allowed to attend school until these requirements have been met**.

New Illinois Department of Public Health rules now mandate all students entering **grade 6th must show proof of having received one dose of Meningococcal vaccine (Meningitis)** and all students entering **grade 12th must show proof of receiving two doses of meningococcal vaccine** (meningitis) unless the first dose was given after the age of 16, then only one dose is required.

Illinois Department of Public Health rules now mandate that all students currently enrolled in grades six through twelve, **shall show proof of receiving one dose of Tdap** (defined as tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis) vaccine regardless of the interval since the last Dtap, DT or Td dose.

EARLY CHILDHOOD Complete Physical Examination dated 08/01/2016 or later upon entry into early childhood. Second year early childhood students do not require an additional exam. A diabetes screening is required. Lead screening is required. A mantoux test for tuberculosis is recommended. The state **requires** the parent complete and sign the health history portion of the examination form.

IMMUNIZATIONS

DPT/DTaP 4 doses (including 1 booster)
IPV/OPV 3 doses (including 1 booster)
Varicella 1 dose after 12 months OR proof of immunity
MMR 1 dose after 12 months
Hepatitis B 3 doses (at appropriate intervals)
Hib 1 dose after 15 months
Pneumococcal 1 dose (if did not receive primary series of vaccine)

KINDERGARTEN Complete Physical Examination dated 08/01/2016 or later. A diabetes screening is required. Lead screening is required. A mantoux test for tuberculosis is recommended. The state **requires** the parent complete and sign the health history portion of the examination form.

IMMUNIZATIONS

DPT/DTaP 4 doses (last one **after** 4th birthday)
IPV/OPV 4 doses (last one **after** 4th birthday)
Varicella 2 dose after 12 months OR proof of immunity
MMR 2 doses after 12 months

1ST GRADE-5TH GRADE Must have previous kindergarten physical on file and be compliant with all immunization requirements.

6TH GRADE Physical examination dated 08/01/2016 or later. A diabetes screening is required. A mantoux test for tuberculosis is recommended. The state **requires** the parent complete and sign the health history portion of the examination form. **MUST** have 3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine at the appropriate intervals. **MUST** show proof of two doses of varicella (chicken pox) or proof of immunity. **MUST** show proof of Tdap. New! **MUST show proof of one dose of Meningococcal Vaccine** (meningitis).

7TH GRADE-8TH GRADE Must have previous 6th grade physical on file and be compliant with all immunizations requirements.

9TH GRADE Physical Examination dated 08/01/2016 or later. A diabetes screening is required. A mantoux test for tuberculosis is recommended. The state **requires** the parent complete and sign the health history portion of the examination form. Must show proof of two doses of varicella (chicken pox) or proof of immunity.

10TH GRADE-11TH GRADE Must have previous 9th grade physical on file and be compliant with all immunization requirements.

12TH GRADE Must have previous 9th grade physical on file and be compliant with all immunization requirements. **NEW- All students entering twelfth grade must show proof of receiving two doses of meningococcal vaccine** (meningitis) unless the first dose was given after the age of 16, then only one dose is required.

Dental Requirements:

A Dental Examination is required for all students in **kindergarten, second and sixth grades**. The examination by a licensed dentist must be completed by May 15 of the school year that the child is in kindergarten, second or sixth grade.

Vision Requirements:

Students enrolling in a **kindergarten** program or enrolling for the first time in a public school shall submit proof of an eye examination. Each child shall present proof of having been examined by a physician licensed to practice medicine in all of its branches or a licensed optometrist within the previous year, before October 15th of the school year.
